### **Overall Notes:**

If the parity of the Minnesota wrestlers is correct, then the addition of Behnke throws the seeding for a loop. He has a better record than Hamer and Gabreab and quite a few more wins than Henle. Because the Henle loss was early in the season and the record is better and Behnke has some good finishes at Regionals in the past, he gets the top seed. After the Minnesota Triangle, Diaz has separated himself with wins over many below him and Wolfenden's wins puts him next with Bohm and Pelkey rounding out the top 8. The rest are unseeded with 7 wins combined. Either Zimmerman or Warren could go for Maranatha. 2 wins between them so either is at the bottom.

### **Gabeab, Hamer and Henle Triangle:**

The Gabeab, Hamer and Henle Triangle is interesting as each has beat one and lost to the other in such a way that no one has an advantage.

### **Overall Notes:**

Tough to seed this weight. Keeter only goes to the top because he beat Hessing, who in turn beat Long. I'd argue that Long has had the best season of the three, but head-to-head doesn't help his case. Keeter's losses to LeDuc and Arne at 157 would have put him no better than fourth at 157 so the move down is a great help here. No matter who he faces he faces in the first round, Keeter should come out a winner and if he faces anybody is 6-8 after that he should get to the semis for a possible match with Seidler (who transferred from Augsburg). Hessing vs. Long in the semis could be interesting as should a Seidler vs. Baxter quarterfinal. The rest of the weight isn't as deep as shakes out with the bottom 4 all having sub .500 records. The Lakeland wrestler is my best guess. This weight is also missing Concordia-Wisconsin's NCAA Champion Sanders, who has been out since November.

Keeter is 25-14 overall, but 11-4 since moving down to 149 at the beginning of February.

### Overall Notes:

Not difficult to seed the top two at all. Arne vs. Weber for third could be argued either way based on head-to-head results. Likewise Kennedy really could go anywhere between 4 and 8. Schrug could be higher if not for the losses to Holtfreter. The last five wrestlers are hard to seed as a group though as Uliana's lone victory came against Koch. Elmer goes ahead of Holtfreter after beating Vandal (Central), who beat Holtfreter. Schurg likely to wrestle above seed and a match vs. LeDuc should be good.

### Augsburg Notes:

As long as there is no further penalty for the disqualification vs. Arne, Kennedy is the front-runner to wrestle for Augsburg. Grant Parker would be the backup at this weight.

Wisconsin-Oshkosh's Nazar Kulchytskyy, a senior from the Ukraine, is 133-5 with 63 pins for his career. That includes a 32-2 mark with 17 pins in 2013-14. The 157-pounder enters the postseason in search of a third consecutive national title: at 157 pounds in 2012 and 165 pounds in 2013.

## Down the stretch

Chad Johnson should certainly be listed as one of Division III's best big men ever with a 132-14 career record with 11 of those losses coming during his freshman season. During the past three seasons, Johnson, already a two-time NCAA champion, has gone 96-3.
